
BACKGROUND



Unioncamere is the public body that coordinates the Italian system of the Chambers of Commerce. The Chambers of Commerce own the official Business Register ("Registro Imprese telematico"), an economic registry and legal disclosure instrument for companies.

InfoCamere, as the technological structure of excellence for supporting the Chamber system, has been appointed with the role of managing the electronic Business Register and keeping it up and running. The Register was established in computerised format from its inception in 1993, and this distinctive feature made it completely unique across Europe.

SOLUTION





The Italian TOOP solution started from scratch, also to demonstrate it is easy and feasible to connect the national services to the network. There were some bumps on the road in the first steps of integration, but they were useful to streamline the whole process and generate better documentation and best practices for future partners.

RESULTS



The Italian TOOP pilot addresses General Business Mobility domain. It reduces bureaucracy and allows citizens to gain access to the richness of data in the Italian Business Register. The expected result is to make one step toward the *Digital Single Market in Europe* based on the interconnection of national systems.
